

Market Report

Bishops Castle Auction – Thursday 4th April 2019

Halls Bishops Castle Auction report a highly successful sale of store cattle at their sale last Thursday 4th April. Trade for the excellent show of 200 cattle was sharper than in the last couple of weeks and produced a total clearance.

Overall, steers averaged 208p/kg and £951/head with highs of 255 p/kg for a Limousin from W. B. & M. E. Harding, Hafan and £1195 for a pair of Limousins from D. P. & M. A. Jones, Poulton. Heifers also averaged 208p/kg and £835/head to a maximum of 236 p/kg for 5 Limousins from E. J. & G. M. Trickey, Moat Farm and £1270 for a Charolais from H. Cooke, Lodge Farm.

Several bulls sold to an average of 200p/kg with a run from G. E. Balmer, The Farm, fetching 236p/kg, 231p/kg, 216p/kg and 215p/kg and F. R. Williams 211p/kg twice.

Also sold was a well-bred pedigree Limousin stock bull from J. S. Vance & Son which sold to a Worcester customer for £3150.
