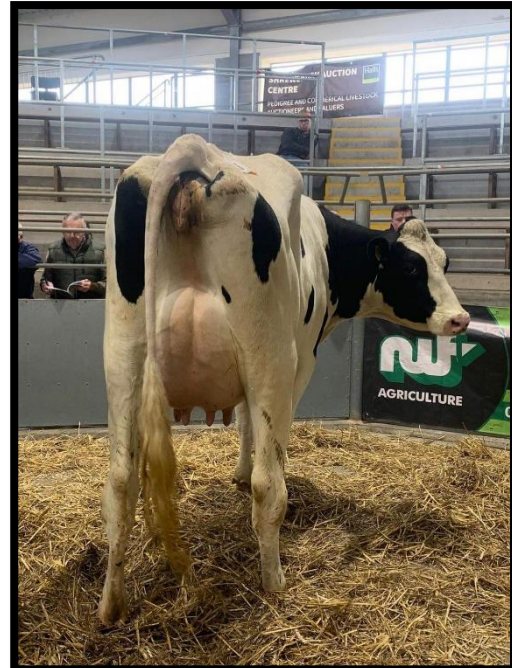

The cows today were a mixed bag to say the least, giving interest to a wide range of buyers and all found competitive bidding and new homes! the top prices with the price winners above outside of these was £1950 for a 3rd lactation Brown Swiss from H Davies and Partners, 3rd lactation British Friesian x from JE, DM, JE Moss £1650. Fleckvieh cows to £1150. Some mid lactation cows due in January straight off the grass peaked at £880

The Heifers offered up a very strong show of quality, with 6 heifers from 6 different vendors in the final short list for the show credit must be given to all our vendors. Congratulations to the prize winners and Mike Owens whos champion was a picture of quality and sold for £2580. One which slipped past the judge's eye was Geral Allsops **ENCHMARSH DOC ETHEL 2** out of a 15000kg dam she had some real class about her and sold giving 35kg for £2550.

Neil Jones has a reputation for selling well-bred quality milkers here and peaked £2300 for FENNSHALL IMAGINE MEG, bred from Bartonhoo Perfection Meg EX95.

A big thank you to Clive Breeze of Breeze Farms Newcastle Emlyn who is making the 3 ½ hour journey on a regular basis to be with us in Shrewsbury selling heifers from his GEUFFORDD Herd 4 today sold to average £2050 to a top of £2250 for **GEUFFORDD EVOLUTION MARY**. The 2nd quality are hard to place, with small frailer heifers and those with faults selling from £1000 to £1600 today, many of these looking a good buy for those who are looking for animals with potential to make tremendous cows.

A 6yo Hereford Stock bull from FG & AM Windsor sold to go onto further work for £1600. Dry cows to £1220 for J Moss of Betley, In Calf Heifers peaked at £1720 for **PIMHILL B52 FLO** from R Mayall and Daughter, Brown Swiss Heifers from Scott Farms sold to £1180, prices for those with faults from at 950.

The youngstock just simply look to be the bargain of the day, very well bred with real potential to make £2000+ fresh heifers in just over 12 months' time peaked at £720 for **SEVENOAKS MERCELLO APPLETIME**, others at £700. March born heifers from this Home at £450. Baby Heifer calves peaked at £200 pon the day with Jersey x heifer calves to £90 (2)

Great numbers on offer this week with plenty of buying power ring side. Something of a two-tier market however with the best half a good firm trade with the plainer half proving easy to home but at less startling prices. Bull calves topped the day at £350 for a belter from Richard Bowdler, and then at £346 for another quality Blue, this time from GP & JH Mountford. Richard Bowdler then weighed in at £334 and £332 while other Blues hit £330 from G & M Povall. Angus bulls sold to £275 again from Park Hall Farm, with Roger Ainsworth selling his to £240. Herefords sold to £180 from Toi Toi

Genetics, while Helen Stubbs sold her run to top at £150. A few nice Simmentals sold to £245 from Harold Davies & Partners. There were a large number of crossbred dairy types all selling, but contributing to decrease averages. Friesian bulls topped at £185 for a strong sort from John Phillips with others to £100 from Darlington Farms. The killing trade seen in previous weeks seems to have cooled, still plenty of demand, but not at what it was.

Heifers topped at £242 for a smart Blue from Park Hall, with plenty of Blue females top side of £220. A couple of cracking Charolais heifers from Peter Lloyd sold to £232 and £220, with several natives on offer, with the best trading £120-160. Plenty of nice well grown angus changing homes only around £100 and would look good value.

We had a nice run of weaned calves up for grabs today seeing spirited bidding topping at £460 for a smashing Lim from DW David & Sons with a nice run of Lims from John Phillips to £450 on three occasions, while heifers from the same home traded at £365 on several occasions.

Halls Holdings Ltd cannot be held responsible for the calf once it leaves the market where the onus transfers to the purchaser.

Welfare of Animals in Livestock Markets.

Halls are proud of the quality of the stock in our market where, with only the very rare exception, stock is always presented for sale in exemplary condition. We have been informed that Welfare of Animals in transit is becoming a hot topic at Food Standards Agency (FSA) and Vets at Abattoirs and while our Markets are **NOT** the subject of any scrutiny, we know that our clients want to stamp out poor practice for the good of the industry and therefore think it appropriate to refresh every one of the standards and the issues which are being reported.

The types of welfare issues that are being reported are mainly to do with prolapses/mastitis/lameness/condition score (very thin sheep). If they are treated on farm and don't improve then the farmer should be putting them down and calling the knackerman, not putting them into the cull sales at markets.

Vendors should ensure that no Animal is presented for Sale if it is Diseased, Ill, Injured or Infirm/Fatigued with consideration of both the market itself and the onward journey to the abattoir.

Any animals not meeting this standard will be returned to their holding of origin

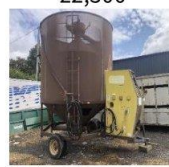
