Again good numbers forward this week, and pleasing to see trade sharper this week with plenty more buying power around the ring. No real strength forward today but still a smart Blue from Helen Stubbs led the way at £340, with a lovely run from Andy wright peaking at £335 again for a blue bull. Loyal supporter Bowdler Farms sold the best of their run to £330 for a Blue bull. Hereford bulls hit

£272 on two occasions from Emmott & Son. Limousin Bulls sold to £280 from DW David, with others to £260 twice from PT Stinton. Other nice bulls sold to £225 for Angus, with the best of the Friesians to £102. Processing trade remains on fire with 3 active buyers battling to ensure a proper trade.

Heifers topped out at £290 for a smart Blue from Bowdler farms and again at £282. TA Wainwright were next in line with a Blue at £280 while Andy Wright sold his best blue female to £275. A smashing young Simmental from ER & RW Adams sold to £265 with plenty of demand for breeding quality female calves. Natives sold to £250 from Emmott & Son for a lovely Hereford with mainly small Angus heifers trading from £100-£140.

Overall, a sharper trade with more demand across the board, with a greater number of second quality sorts on offer today.

Welfare of Animals in Livestock Markets.

Halls are proud of the quality of the stock in our market where, with only the very rare exception, stock is always presented for sale in exemplary condition. We have been informed that Welfare of Animals in transit is becoming a hot topic at Food Standards Agency (FSA) and Vets at Abattoirs and while our Markets are **NOT** the subject of any scrutiny, we know that our clients want to stamp out poor practice for the good of the industry and therefore think it appropriate to refresh every one of the standard and the issues which are being reported.

The types of welfare issues that are being reported are mainly to do with prolapses/mastitis/lameness/condition score (very thin sheep). If they are treated on farm and don't improve then the farmer should be putting them down and calling the knackerman, not putting them into the cull sales at markets. Vendors should ensure that no Animal is presented for Sale if it is Diseased, Ill, Injured or Infirm/Fatigued with consideration of both the market itself and the onward journey to the abattoir.

Any animals not meeting this standard will be returned to their holding of origin

Mediums sold to average 251.55p/kilo and £107.62/head and sold up to 296p/kilo from M/s FC Roberts Wolfshead Farm and £125/head from M/s I T Manning, The Smithy.

Heavies sold to average 249.79p/kilo and £117.69/head and sold up to 261p/kilo from V J Bromley, Betton Abbots and £129.50 from M/s I T Manning, The Smithy.

Overweight sold to average 236.92p/kilo and £136.63/head and sold up to 241p/kilo and £150/head from M/s DR Evans, Brook House.

A good show of weanlings with plenty of offer with all sorts throughout from strong heifers nearly ready for stores to the smaller steers that would go on to do very well there was plenty on offer. A brisk trade had throughout particularly on the older end of the weanlings those nearer the store section.

Steers topped at £1,025 for a 14month old Hereford from Crows Agricultural Ltd, £1,025 for an 18month old LIM X from F. L. Jones, Friars Park Farm and to £970 for an 11month old Hereford also from Crows Agricultural Ltd. Steers Average £665. Heifers topping at £1,230 for a cracking 2 ½ year old LIM X Heifer from D. W. David and Sons, Braggington Hall Farm, £790 for 3 x LIM X Heifers 12month olds from W. G. Bebbington and Sons, Hargrove Farm and £790 again for W. G. Bennington and Sons for 3 x British Blue 12month old Heifers. Heifers Average £531

A decent entry of Bulls met a reliable trade topping at £940 for a 11month old LIM X Bull from E. R. & K. C. Brown, Old Farm and to £910 for the same aged LIM X bulls from the same home and then to £810 for 3 x LIM X 7month olds from F, Karle, Firs Farm. Bulls Average £542
