FANTASTIC NUMBERS

FORWARD AGAIN – AND GREAT QUALITY! The market was a buzz with the crowd 2 deep at ringside from the start. The trade is starting to show the effects of the milk price, as I think we would all expect there is also a number of buyers busy getting maize in while catching up with field work! Buyers able to be a little picky, as the saying goes “If you’re going to feed one you might as well feed a good one” Fortunately that is what is on offer in Shrewsbury every week!

Top price cow today £2350 for returning vendor PB Sutton & Partners with **HURCOTT MIAMI GERRY 3 GP84**, a tremendous example giving 48kg a day after completing a yield of over 10000 litres in her heifer lactation she sold to a flying herd south of Shrewsbury. Other 2nd lactation cows today achieved £1880 and £1500 for Malcolm Trevor Jones with x bred sorts selling at £1000 on 3 Occasions. A ¾ cow achieved £980

Heifers also peaked at £2350 for **PIMHILL SASSFRAS COTTON** from D & AC Shakeshaft, a picture of a heifer which would have looked great on show and sale day, giving 30kg. another from the same home by the great SSI Montross Duke achieved £2000. A 34kg Heifer from PB Sutton by Peak Tropic **HURCOTT TROPIC CINDERELLA** sold for £2200 a Crushabull from the same home £2000, A commercial heifer from Mark Hughes of Criggion romped to £2100. There was then a flurry of heifers selling from £1800 to £1900 for a number of different vendors.

A 5yo Hereford bull achieved a wonderful £2100 for H Forbes of Church Stretton, while a young angus from MA Smith of Whitchurch sold for £1850. An in-calf Heifer from RP & NH Birchell of Stafford due soon to the Angus **HAZELCROFT PARTY-TIME CONTENTED** sold for £1380. Pedigree Bulling Heifers from Keith Mather, Lynn sold for £780 (3). Weaned Heifer calves to £290 (4) for HV Wright & Son, Tarporley sweet heifer calves from Richard Boulder Ltd sold to £220 (2) starting from £180.

Halls were delighted to conducted the dispersal sale of the **WYCHERLEY** Herd on behalf of GP & SC Whittingham, from Wycherley Hall, Bagley Ellesmere. The herd of 54 cows and heifers plus youngstock had not been pushed having produced all their milk from grass. Buyers travelled from Warwickshire, Derbyshire as well as our local company of buyers

In the absence of fresh milk, the sale was topped at 1650gns for **WYCHERLEY BOMBERO DOROTHY** a July calved heifer giving 24kg. a Heifer due to calf in December **WYCHERLEY DEALMAKER NICOLA** still giving 21kg sold for 1520gns.

Cows from this home peaked at 1550gns for the first cow in the ring **WYCHERLEY PISTON NATASHA** a cow which was giving 22kg having calved in June, recently served. The same 1550gn was achieved by **WYCHERLEY HURST SHANNA** who was due with her 4th calf in March 2023.

Dry cows peaked at 1300gns. Correct balanced cows saw ready bidding from 900-1300gns as while trade for anything off note was from 700-1000gns

The youngstock were the trade of the day as buyers could see the potential the breeding offered on more intensive systems. Heifers due in March achieved 1300gns for **WYCHERLEY BOMBERO CASS**, others for the same month to 1200gns, with those just PD+ outside of the sales warranty selling up to 1000gns. The bulling heifers met a strong trade also peaking at 900gns on 2 occasions with only 5 of the 18 selling for 720gns or less

Charolais bulls topped out at £395 from J Wainwright, with blues from J & S Doherty to £358 along with R Bowdler Ltd who sold to £378 also. Limousins sold to £355 again from J Wainwright & Son. All of the best Continentals £300-£340 with second quality types £250-

£300.

Overall, 40 Blue bulls sold to average £263. Simmental bulls topped at £292 from H Davies & Partners with P Stinton selling to £318 for his Limousins.

Natives a proper trade also topping at £220 for a red Hereford bull from Emmott & Sons, with others to £215 from Downing -Booth. A lovely Angus bull from D & AC Shakeshaft sold to £194 with S Ford & Son selling theirs to £190.

Friesian Bulls, a serious trade again selling to £145 from G & M Povall with G & M Lewis selling his bi run to £98. Overall, 70 Friesians sold averaged £70.57.

Halls Holdings Ltd cannot be held responsible for the calf once it leaves the market where the onus transfers to the purchaser.

Welfare of Animals in Livestock Markets.

Halls are proud of the quality of the stock in our market where, with only the very rare exception, stock is always presented for sale in exemplary condition. We have been informed that Welfare of Animals in transit is becoming a hot topic at Food Standards Agency (FSA) and Vets at Abattoirs and while our Markets are **NOT** the subject of any scrutiny, we know that our clients want to stamp out poor practice for the good of the industry and therefore think it appropriate to refresh every one of the standards and the issues which are being reported.

The types of welfare issues that are being reported are mainly to do with prolapses/mastitis/lameness/condition score (very thin sheep). If they are treated on farm and don't improve then the farmer should be putting them down and calling the knackerman, not putting them into the cull sales at markets.

Vendors should ensure that no Animal is presented for Sale if it is Diseased, Ill, Injured or Infirm/Fatigued with consideration of both the market itself and the onward journey to the abattoir.

Any animals not meeting this standard will be returned to their holding of origin

NEW TB LICENSING RULES FOR ORANGE MARKET!

The APHA has altered the licensing rules for the animals coming to Dedicated TB Sales with the introduction of the TB16e. There announce is here below:

When the keeper requests a licence to move cattle to a TB dedicated sale (orange market), whenever possible, this new TB16e licence will be issued. It will have a 'valid until date' completed by APHA, and there may be additional conditions. For breakdown herds in Wales, when the next test is the potential clearing test, an additional condition of 'Only valid for calves under 90 days old' will usually be added.

The keeper can copy the original licence as many times as necessary during its validity period. Each time they want to consign cattle to a TB dedicated sale (orange market), the keeper will need to complete Part 2 of the licence with details of the destination premises (i.e., the orange market's name and address) and add the details of the cattle that they will be moving:

- *official animal identifier (ear tag number)*
- *date of birth*
- *date of last TB test (if a pre-movement test is required, so no need for this to be completed for calves under 42 days old).*

The licence must travel with the cattle to the TB dedicated sale (orange market).

In essence the TB16e removes the need for license requests to be made to APHA 5 working days prior to a sale date and therefore makes the licensing process far similar for the farmer and market operator.

This rule change comes into effect on the **2nd October 2023**. Our next TB orange market will be held on Wednesday 18th October 2023. We look forward to welcoming more entries now we are no hindered by the 5 working day rule. If you are unfortunate enough to be under TB Restriction make sure you request a TB16e license so you can continue to trade.
