THE TRADE HOLDS HIGH ONCE MORE as the demand for the top quality fresh was perhaps higher this week! There is undoubtedly a two-tier trade as the best continue to sell at very pleasing levels while anything with a bit shelly or with a fault harder to place.

The cows today were led by a 3rd lactation black legged cow from Messrs B & M Elkin which saw rapid bidding before selling to a Cheshire holding at £2300. Other Holstein cows to £1580, Brown Swiss giving 45kg £1320. Senior and ¾ cows today sold from £750-£980.

Heifers met a very good and consistent demand throughout the best peaking at £2400 for **JAYBURN PEPPER TORCH** who was giving 31kg and after starting at £2000 flew to £2400. A wonderful pair of heifers from G & JL & RW Pritchard sold to £2350 firstly for **DAWNSTAR FYNN CHERRY**, a well balance heifer giving 34kg Her Herdmate **DAWNSTAR PHARO CHERRY 118** sold to the same flying herd at £2200. A heifer from the best family at WA Jones & Sons renowned Fennshall herd also sold for £2200 she was **FENNSHALL FRANSISCO SALLY 3** and was giving 30kg. Mark Hughes peaked at £2150 for **GWERNYGO PEPPER MAGGIE 3**, A heifer which is going to grow into a great cow. Our most distant consigner today was J Williams & Son from Porthmadog who sold the pick of his 2yo heifers at £2100, she was **GLASWYN SPOCK MARIAN 71** giving 25kg a rising she was a great cow maker. Forst time consigner AC Hocknell of Coton topped the commercial heifers with a Pine Tee Defence daughter giving 30kg sold at £1980. Nice youthful Holstein heifers from £1500-£2000. Norwegian Red x Heifers from Scott Farms Ltd giving 25kg sold for £1250 & £1220 those with faults from £800-£1100.

A run of out of block Dry cows from Edge Farming peaked at £1320 (2) for **WIMBOLDSLEY REGINALD BINNIE 2 VG85** who was due with her 3rd to the Longhorn in December, a pair of cows in calf to Angus for November sold for £1100.

In Calf Heifers from JGP Lewis & Co of Cefnllwynpïod, Aberystwyth, peaked at £1580 for YSTWYTH GATEWAY MARY, who was due on the 28th November to Westcoast Swingman Red. Another pair at £1250.

An increased entry this week, with a good run of continentals along with a big run of smaller natives. Plenty of our usual customers around the ring with a number of returning faces we haven't seen for a while. Overall, a very pleasing trade with Blue bulls topping out at £340 to highlight a great run from Richard Bowdler. Peter Lloyd sold his usual quality Charolais to a high of £335 with other Blue bulls from the Bowdler brothers trading between £310-335. Other Blues from Harold Davies & Partners sold at £308 with smart Lims

from J & B Richards to £300 on a number of occasions. Plenty of natives around today with Angus bulls to £200 from RJ & BJ George while Herefords sold to £200 also this time from Mr Allen. Plenty of medium Native bulls £140-160 with the smaller end around the £100 mark. Friesian bulls another smart trade with the processing market holding values up well. Heifers still a very good trade with a reamer from CT Pain selling to £340 for a Charolais with the best of the Blues to £284 from Richard Bowdler, and again at £280. Plenty of the better end Blue heifers £240-260 with medium types around the £200 mark. Natives saw strong Hereford females to £280 from RJ & BJ George with nice medium Hereford heifers £140-160. Plenty of the native heifers were on the smaller side, slipping into a very buoyant processing market. Other continental heifers saw Charolais to £180 from Peter Lloyd and Lims from J & B Richards to £235. Again, good numbers needed for next week, with demand remaining firm. Welfare of Animals in Livestock Markets.

Halls are proud of the quality of the stock in our market where, with only the very rare exception, stock is always presented for sale in exemplary condition. We have been informed that Welfare of Animals in transit is becoming a hot topic at Food Standards Agency (FSA) and Vets at Abattoirs and while our Markets are **NOT** the subject of any scrutiny, we know that our clients want to stamp out poor practice for the good of the industry and therefore think it appropriate to refresh every one of the standards and the issues which are being reported.

The types of welfare issues that are being reported are mainly to do with prolapses/mastitis/lameness/condition score (very thin sheep). If they are treated on farm and don't improve then the farmer should be putting them down and calling the knackerman, not putting them into the cull sales at markets.

Vendors should ensure that no Animal is presented for Sale if it is Diseased, Ill, Injured or Infirm/Fatigued with consideration of both the market itself and the onward journey to the abattoir.

Any animals not meeting this standard will be returned to their holding of origin

NEW TB LICENSING RULES FOR ORANGE MARKET!

The APHA has altered the licensing rules for the animals coming to Dedicated TB Sales with the introduction of the TB16e. There announce is here below:

When the keeper requests a licence to move cattle to a TB dedicated sale (orange market), whenever possible, this new TB16e licence will be issued. It will have a 'valid until date' completed by APHA, and there may be additional conditions. For breakdown herds in Wales, when the next test is the potential clearing test, an additional condition of 'Only valid for calves under 90 days old' will usually be added.

The keeper can copy the original licence as many times as necessary during its validity period. Each time they want to consign cattle to a TB dedicated sale (orange market), the keeper will need to complete Part 2 of the licence with details of the destination premises (i.e., the orange market's name and address) and add the details of the cattle that they will be moving:

- *official animal identifier (ear tag number)*
- *date of birth*
- *date of last TB test (if a pre-movement test is required, so no need for this to be completed for calves under 42 days old).*

The licence must travel with the cattle to the TB dedicated sale (orange market).

In essence the TB16e removes the need for license requests to be made to APHA 5 working days prior to a sale date and therefore makes the licensing process far similar for the farmer and market operator.

This rule change comes into effect on the **2nd October 2023**. Our next TB orange market will be held on Wednesday 18th October 2023. We look forward to welcoming more entries now we are no hindered by the 5 working day rule. If you are unfortunate enough to be under TB Restriction make sure you request a TB16e license so you can continue to trade.
