What a difference a week in the dairy trade makes, much more boyant bidding and trade and a few new purchasers brought about an increased average of £200+ on the week. The cow trade topped today with a youthful second calver from GE Jones & Co with Cernant Amplify Nora, this GP83 scored cow yielding at 43kg less a month fresh she sold for £2150. Not far behind was a tank of a Friesian from another regular Malcolm Trevor Jones fresh 10 days and yielding 33kg she sold for £2020 along with her herdmate of a similar type making £1950. The cow average includes a couple of 2010 born cows which sold to £720 giving 30kg with Spring round the corner this looked good value today.

The fresh heifers today were of the tremendous quality that we have weekly and the top heifer today would be home at any show, with great power for a young heifer and what an udder! she was Styche Chief August from Tony Scott, Stapeley a heifer with a fantastic pedigree and yielding 38kg she sold for £2500. Taking second spot today was the second heifer in a trio from the Shepherd family was Meldamar Pursuit Belle 139, this Pine Tree Pursuit heifer fresh a month she sold for £2320, the remainder of the trio sold for £2100 and £2000 to give a very respectable average of £2140. Also at the top of the tree again was Brian Buxton with Wilderley Altakiki Rosy 2 this January 2022 born heifer fresh a couple of weeks she sold for £2280. Malcolm Trevor Jones also sold a quality heifer sister to a flashy red heifer he sold a couple of weeks ago for £2250 the buyers certainly appreciated this silky black heifer too. Tony Scotts second heifer sired by Wilder Dalliance and purchased as a calf in the Darlington dispersal this quality heifer also made £2120. Friesian type heifers very fresh and just getting started sold to £900. With cross bred types to £925.

Cows and Calves soared to £1780 for a 3yo Limousin Cow from Fred Karle with Lim Heifer at foot, monty heifers with limousin calves at foot peaked at £1460 for GG Rees & Son, while Ray Humphreys senior blonde cow with heifer sold for £1360.

Bulls peaked at £880 for an 8mo Beef Shorthorn from JN Butler of Pentre Aaron, while a pen of 4 Limousin from WT Jones of Argeod achieved the same good price. 5mo Dairy Bred Blue bulls to £500, Holstein Friesian the same age from the same home of FG & AM Windsor sold for £340.

The top steers today were a pair of Limousins from SA & EA Ackerley of Crewe, who sold another at £850, a smart 8mo blue from TW Goldstraw achieved £820, In the dairy breeds the top price was £790 for a pair of 9mo Steers from Adam Hatton, an 8mo Blue from B & M Elkin achieved £720, Yearling Hereford bullocks were well sought after selling to £690 for RJ & CH Lloyd of Cae Howell.

Heifers peaked at £915 for a pair of beauty's from WT Jones of Argoed the best blue heifer from TW Goldstraw sold for £870. With Limousins from SA & EA Ackerley at 10mo selling for £860. Yearling Blue Heifers from ST Morris of Worthen sold to £700, 11mo Heifers from A Hatton £670. A pen of 7mo Blue Heifers from R Brassington £625. Not many just weaned heifers today but plenty of customers at the ringside with £380-£480 to spend of any and all types of small yearling throughout the sale
