Another great trade for dairy today, maybe a few days of vitamin D had helped everyone to see Spring really is around the corner. Starting with a fantastic line up of cows today with as much milk as you could ask for. The top cow from JM & D Shepherd & Sons, Hassop with their ultra youthful 2 nd calver Meldamar Drafter Flora 69 this Relough Drafter daughter giving 51kg she sold for £2250. Spearing & Griffiths also dispersing through the weekly sales also sold a 2nd calver calved 2 weeks also over 50kg she sold for £2120 this cow was already at 5.30% Fat & 3.30% Protein with an immaculate cell count. Her herdmate also sold for £1700. Another regular consigner Alistair Drinkall sold Stella Allegro Carina a 3rd calver at 45kg she sold for £2020. Close behind was another weekly dispersal GE Jones & Co, Ty Cerrig with Cernant Mirage Admire 2 GP84 this 3rd calver giving 42kg at a huge 5.21% Fat and 4.40% Protein sold for £1950. Onto the heifer trade which continued its upward trend here at Shrewsbury up again over £100 on the week. With over half over the £2000 barrier. Heading the trade was RJ & RH Gadsbey, Yarlet with Freeford Altaamulet Rosemary at 34kg, this fortnight calved heifer made £2450.

Another of his trio Wimboldsley Villanova Ada which sold for £2200 both at a month calved, his trio averaged £2190. The Shepherd family also sold a trio to top at £2350 for Meldamar Applicable Lady Ruth 223 already scored VG85 and at 32kg, this really was a super sweet heifer with quality right through and so balanced. The following lot made £2320 Meldamar Dalliance Vogue 201 had calved a month and was sure to develop too. This trio also averaged an impressive £2163. Other vendors at the top today included Dawnstar Pharo Amelia 8 at 34kg she sold for £2250 for G & JL & RW Pritchard. Another super trio from Tony Scott, Stapeley topped at £2100 for Styche Taz Stella calved a couple of weeks and from the quality herd of the Seaton family originally. At the same price was a super heifer from JW & CA Roberts with a heifer sired by Outlaw.

Also in the sale today was a group of dry cows due in the coming month to beef from Millward Farms who are dispersing they topped at £1200 for Hillsummer Altarecoil Wallesy, due with her 3rd to Limousin. A really super in calf heifer, really stretchy and due in early summer from RR & VI Evans, Rowton sired by Maui and due to sexed semen, she sold for £1400. A couple of Jersey in calf heifers due to Jersey sold to £650.

A group of bulling heifer sold to £870 for a strong pair of heifers born in December 2021 & February 2022. With the smaller lighter heifers proving harder to market, stronger types were certainly in demand and sold as such.

Looking forward to next week with an early entry of 22 Fresh Calved heifers from the Puertomadryn Herd, D Jones, Pwllheli, these include a 2nd calver, 18 Pedigree Holstein heifers, 12 Fleckvieh x Heifers and a Jersey x heifer. This herd ticks all the boxes Low TB Risk Area, BVD Double Gold Free, Lepto & IBR Free and Johnes Free/Monitored. The Herd averages 8500kg 4.63% Fat and 3.26% Protein with a CC 77.

This is a youthful group from an exposed coastful farm bred for Legs and Feet, Udders, Balance and Fertility – DO NOT MISS THE OPPORTUNITY!!
