Smaller numbers today than in a while but with the Show & Sale next week this is be expected. It was quality as usual today without the quantity. Taking top spot in the fresh cows today at £2220 was great supporters JM & D Shepherd, Hassop with their Meldamar Amerix Victoria 89 GP84 having given over 11000kg last time she is already up to 52kg. This just pipped an equally strong cow from Rob Higgins Bentleyford, she was Pendyffryn Nolan Ethel this VG86 3rd calver already up at 46kg she had given over 10000kg in her first two lactations she made £2100. Also over the £2000 mark today was Ystwyth Impact Ebony a 2nd calver at 36kg from JGP Lewis & Co, another second calver from GE Jones & Co, Ty Cerrig also with a second calver Cernant Amplify Catrin 2 also well over 40kg made £1920.

Onto the heifers and week in and out our vendors bring forward top draw quality heifers and this week was no exception. With half the heifers over £2000 top trade today at £2280 was the top price of the day was again the Shepherd family with Meldamar Darwin Victoria 108, this daughter of Siemers Darwin calved a month and at 31kg. This was closely followed by another much admired heifer from Mark Hughes his Cottonabbotts Citizen Jewel, this fresh calved heifer by Denovo 3303 Citizen and fresh ready to go on made £2180. Close behind was Alisdair Drinkall with a Pine-Tree Verona sired heifer at £2150 only just ahead of super heifer from GE Jones at £2120 Cernant Sedona Admire GP81. Another great heifer was brought forward from JB & J Cambridge Cottonabbotts Medel P Violet she made £2100.

There were a couple of lighter heifers in today which were harder to place at £800-900 but have the summer ahead to improve.

A couple of in calf heifers due in early summer in sexed semen sold very well today to top at £1820 for Hillsummer Alta amulet Wallesy with her herd mate at £1660.

The Job was absolutely electric today with bidders 3 deep at the ringside, dare I say twice the number could have been sold such was the fierce demand

witnessed today in Shrewsbury.

Blue bulls a fierce trade today, peaked for a 27day old bull from Richard Bowdler which sold for £410, Messrs Davies and Monksfield not far from the action at £400, Messrs Pain & Coleman sold bulls for £395 and James Paddock as also right in amongst the big money achieving £390! A tremendous 1 month old Hereford bull from Beckbury Farm of Shifnal sold for £340, another from the same farm £330. A 17-day old Hereford calf sold for £255 for Eddie Studley of Chester. 1mo Angus bull calves were topped at ER & RW Adam of Sascott with a sweet thick calf at £285. All bonny beef calves easily sold to a flurry of bids from all over the ringside.

Heifer calves every bit as rapid as the bulls with at least 10 blue heifer calves all under 42days old selling for more than £305. The section topper was £345 for JR Paddock of Whitton Farm, closely followed by the best from Richard Bowdler today at £328. Limousin heifer calves sold to £260 for Richard Bowdler Ltd. Fresh Hereford heifer calves from Mick Emmot, out of Montbeliarde cows achieved £290, nice batching type Hereford heifer calves from £160-£170 presented by vendors from Shropshire, Staffordshire and Aberystwyth.

For the second week running we had some Wagyu calves forward with the all singing all dancing integrated supply train supply unable to live up to its promises, trade peaked at £148 for bulls and 110 for heifers

Some strong calves today from 3 different vendors peaked at £520 for a 4mo Hereford Bull from JW Roberts of Overton, £480 for Angus from DF Brassington. 3mo Limousins from PT Stinton of Ludlow a flying trade aching £490 for bull calves 3mo and £480(3) for Heifers the same age!
