WHAT ANOTHER FANTASTIC DAY FOR THE SHOW & SALE! Firstly, a huge thank you to our very capable judge Mrs Sally Thomasson, Norbury who was very efficient in sorting through the quality line up and selecting her class and overall winners. Secondly a thank you to all the vendors who brought forward another tremendous quality selection for this month's show and sale and also to the new and returning buyers for making for a lively trade.

The cow section today was topped by another great young cow from GE Jones & Co, Ty Cerrig with his Cernant Grazie Regina 2 GP83 this 2nd calver yielding 49kg nearly a month calved, having yielded over 9000kg as a heifer she was an absolute picture today. This was followed by the Reserve Champion and winning cow today from another regular vendor brought forward by Ben Brassington and family Whinchat Unix Ideal Ideal she was also a month into her second lactation and was much admired for her great power and balance. Also, over the £2000 mark today was Meldamar Amerix Surprise 43 GP83 a 3rd calver from the Shepherds, Hassop having given 12417kg in her 2nd she was close to 60kg in her third just a couple of weeks fresh. George Thomas and family were back again this month with Wolston Aladdin Lavender 52 another in her 2nd calved in Mid-May she made £2000.

There were a number of cows also in the high teens today these were high yielding and powerful cows. On the day older and less fleshed cows were harder to sell.

Onto the heifers, today the trade was topped by Wolston Manana Lavender 62 from AD & RM Thomas this stylish heifer came 3rd in the pre-show sale and looked a picture having been calved 3 weeks and yielding 33kg, she sold for £2480. She was very closely followed by M & JC Gould with Whinchat Milano Shula from the heart of Picston Shottles family and backed by 10 generations VG/EX she was a true cow maker. She made £2450. Also at £2450 today was the 1st placed heifer and Champion from the Pritchard family, Berriew. Dawnstar Generate Empress 249, calved in early May and on 32kg she was a stretchy black heifer from this great herd of cows. Her herd mates also both made over £2000 at £2220 and £2150 which was testament to their quality on the day. Close behind the leading prices it was great to see PB Sutton back today at Shrewsbury, selling Hurcott Ultrasound Jae 3 sired by a home bred sire she had great width and strength which the buyers liked today she sold for £2350 along with 3 others from 3 other vendors Paul & Becky Fenton with Tibbenham Sedona Katherine 11 having been 2nd placed heifer. GE Jones & Co with Cernant Sedona Admire 3 and RJ Clare & Partners with a super fresh stylish heifer Hawksmoor Zoe sired by Wilder Dalliance and calved a month. WJ Jones, Farlow brought a couple of dry cows due to the Limousin stock bull for later in the year these topped at £2000 for a wealthy young cow.

In calf heifers were certainly not short on quality today with a top of £1650 for the second week running for R Fowler & Sons, Hanbury with Hillsummer Ardour Dierdre due to Sexed Altaizza or Angus for mid-July close behind was Hillsummer Altamulet Wilma £1600 she was due to sexed Altailed at the end of June. A couple of further off heifers due to Longhorn for late autumn made to £1200.

Maiden heifers topped at £880 for a Holstein Friesian heifer born in Nov 2022, only for sale due to being out of block for Mrs G Potter, Plox Green a super well grown group of heifers.

Heifer calves completed the weeks mantra of having every age group available today with Golbourne Crazyed Maple Lee 2 born on 1st May with a 12000kg dam she sold for £240. A duo of great calves from Meldamar made £200 each.

Thank you again for your continued support at this week's sale it was great to see returning buyers and vendors from across the midlands and beyond.
