WHAT A DAY FOR SHREWSBURY LIVESTOCK CENTRE!

What can only be described as a day of immense trading here started off in the cow section.

Top call today went to GE Jones, Ty Cerrig with Cernant Atrium Easy GP83, this 3rd calver giving 45kg which had been placed 3rd in the pre-sale show sold for £2720 her herdmate also made £2250.

Second in the show and also in the price league table was a Brown Swiss cross from regular vendors H Davies, Puddington she sold for £2520 this fresh 3rd calver giving 48kg fresh a week. Finishing the trio of prize winners in the cow section was a tremendous fresh 3rd calver from the Wilson Family, Leebotwood, this Yoda sired cow fresh at the start of June and giving 38kg she sold for £2300. With half the cows over the £2000 mark also of note was Meldamar Pursuit Dream 142 this stylish 2nd calver also pulled out for the show.

Onto the heifers and what can we say other than WOW, if there was any doubt that trade is lifting along with the mood with the fantastic weather, we are currently blessed with this was it!

A top call today was a record for 2024 so far with WA Jones & Son taking top spot today with Wilderley Harley Hunday 3, this Genhotel Harley P daughter giving 30kg having calved in early June.

Also at the £3000 mark today was Meldamar Pursuit Belle 131 calved on the 1st June and sired by Pine-Tree Pursuit she was another fantastic heifer from JM & D Shepherd such great supporters of the sale weekly. It was another very regular vendor that took third spot in the heifer prices and pre-sale show making £2600 for Criggion Bradnick Susan another fresh heifer sired by Bradnick

This was certainly a testament to Hannahs judging – Well Done Hannah!

Only just behind this was another heifer from WA Jones & Son, Fennsbank Sedona Sally 3, this fresh heifer giving 30kg sold for £2500. There were 11 heifers in total over £2000, and none the less from Alistair Drinkall who sold a very sweet fresh heifer Hillsummer Altaamulet Wallesy calved 2 weeks and almost at 30kg, selling for £2450 just a little behind was DC & JB Clowes with a heifer calved 11 days she sold for £2350 after a second placing in the show. A late entry from Mr Roberts the Graig, sold at £2300 for Tarporley Kendrix Dot fresh 8 days.

A very nice trio of in calf heifers all in calf to beef sires were topped today by an absolute nailer of a heifer Jacmass Judy 21 sired by Denmire Raxin she is sure to make a great heifer for her buyer who paid £1850 today.

A really great show of bulling heifers was brought in today from some great herds, first up was the Shepherds with a dozen or so from their superb Meldamar herd. These were topped today with Meldamar Darwin Rosa 51 this March 2023 born heifer is sure to develop well, she was closely followed by Meldamar Sidekick Lisa 191 also making £830, the group averaged £736. Another well grown group from P & M Timmis also sold to a top of £800 for Westvalley Daredevil Pauline 394 for a 14month old heifer.

There were a lovely group of heifer calves in today too mainly from Meldamar with a top call of £270 for Meldamar Chase Dream 202 at nearly a month old.

Congratulations must go to the Shepherd family with their success last week at the Lincolnshire Show, their 5th calver took the Holstein Championship and went onto to be Reserve in the Interbreed Classes the following day. She also scored a very impressive EX95 on the Friday, WELL DONE!

Of course, we are always looking forward to the next week and the first sale of July, we already have entries on the books and with this trade surely SHREWSBURY is the place to be contact the team
