Topping the cows today with a joint top call was a Brown Swiss 3rd calver giving 46kg she was very fresh at 7 days calved. She was joined on the podium by GE Jones & Co, Ty Cerrig also selling for £2500 with Cernant Mixer Valentine GP80 a 4th calver fresh on the 20th June and close to 50kg. A trio of young cows from new vendor GM Windsor, Lydbury North also brought a great return to average £2126.66 with a top of £2200 for Hendomen Lead 125 GP82 this second calver fresh just over a month and yielding 39kg & rising.

Onto the heifers and it was another new vendor Summerfield Holsteins from Whitmore who topped the heifers and the sale with Summerfield Summerfest Hells Bells this Avant-Garde I KD Summerfest daughter was a definite eye catcher and was secured at £2680. The trio from the Summerfield family averaged a truly impressive £2443.33. Close behind today was regular vendor CSA Brassington with Cracking Goldsun Nellie calved a couple of weeks and yielding 33kg. Also coming in at £2380 from WA Jones & Son, Fennsbank Rubels Sally, a joint price of £2350 from Mark Hughes and Messrs Owen and another great heifer from Paul Knight with a price of £2320 for Clywedog PB Marie 3134 this Vogue Landslide heifer looked a real cow maker. Very few smaller types forward today or ¾ which were around £1150 today.

Next week is July Show & Sale – where did July go! This will be judged by Mr Clive Norbury and a good entry is expected from the regular vendors. Also following the show and sale we have a really genuine dispersal from Drury Lane Farms, Minsterley. Today's market report for lambs showcases a vibrant and promising trade, with several vital highlights that should excite sellers. The figures from today's Shrewsbury reflect a dynamic market with competitive pricing, exceptional vendor performances, excellent quality, and well-meated lambs on offer.

Lightweight lambs between 17 and 25 kg were few but averaged 208.33 p/kg, with a top price of 208 p/kg. F and SM Schofield led the way, securing the highest price per head at £50. Higher prices for light lambs hinge significantly on their quality and meat content. When these lambs are well-meated and exhibit superior quality traits, they capture buyer interest and fetch top-tier prices at the market.

Despite slightly lower averages for 25.5-32 kg lambs this week, with an average price of 263 p/kg compared to the previous week's 275.29 p/kg, the market remained strong and consistent. This resilience is a testament to the market's stability. F and SM Schofield achieved top results again, with the highest cost per head at £84. Quality, well-bred lambs with good meat in this weight range are needed to fetch excellent prices.

The 32.1-39 kg category shone brightly this week, with average prices increasing from 293.66 p/kg to 306.35 p/kg. Today, the top price reached 333 p/kg, achieved by M Cordiner, who also secured the highest price per head at £120.

This underscores the robust demand for continental-bred lambs in this weight range, rewarding vendors with top prices for their premium stock. The superior meat quality and desirable characteristics typically associated with continental breeds continue to drive this demand.

Medium-weight lambs (39.1-45.5 kg) maintained a robust performance, with an average price of 296.09 p/kg, up 5ppk from last week's 290.73 p/kg. Davies, Monksfield achieved the top ppk, 320 p/kg. JK & LJ Bithell and JH Jones & Sons topped the price per head at £137.50. These figures reflect strong demand for well-meated and high-quality lambs, ensuring lucrative returns.

Heavy lambs, 45.6-52 kg, showcased the market's consistent strength, with an average price of 301.73 p/kg, just above the previous week's 298.5 p/kg. MJ & RJ Lewis achieved the top price per kilogram at 310 p/kg, while DA & MJ Embrey secured the highest price per head at £155.50. These results highlight the high value placed on heavier lambs, reinforcing the market's stability and profitability.

Overweight lambs over 52 kg, the average price was 266.52 p/kg, with a top price of 288 p/kg achieved by FW Downes. The highest price per head was £158, secured by JA Dyke. Although there was a slight dip from last week's 267.76 p/kg, the top prices per head remained strong, reflecting ongoing demand for the heaviest lambs and ensuring excellent returns for quality stock.

This week, our average price per kilogram soared to 297.5 p/kg, marking an impressive increase of 5 pence per kilogram from last week's 292.67 p/kg. Similarly, the SQQ rose to

297.58 p/kg, up from 290.88 p/kg. These remarkable figures underscore a thriving and fiercely competitive market where your commitment to delivering quality livestock is rewarded with enthusiastic bidding and substantial returns. The average price settled at £100 per head, reflecting a slight decrease of £20 from the previous week but maintaining parity with yesterday's market averages. Top prices soared to £168.50, exemplified by DM & DR Clarke's exceptional offering, highlighting strong buyer interest and the market's willingness to reward quality. Several lots achieved outstanding prices today, with many surpassing the £150 mark. Notable sales included £160 by R Holt, £155 by both BT & SA Hinks and RT Edwards & Sons, £151 by R Holt, and £150 by J & T Powell.
