



REPORT FOR THE STORE CATTLE THURSDAY 11TH JULY 2024

We are thrilled to share the results of our latest Store Cattle Sale on 11 July 2024. The enthusiasm and turnout were extraordinary, reflecting the high-quality Cattle brought to Market by our esteemed Vendors.

Store Steers:

The Store Steers section saw a remarkable array of Cattle, with a total tally of 45 heads. These averaged an impressive 259.73ppk, with the highest price reaching 352.1ppk. R J and G D Talbot delivered outstanding animals, contributing significantly to the success. Steers consistently show growth potential, drawing the attention of a keen set of 21 Buyers. Per head, the Store Steers averaged an impressive £1182, but the real highlight was the jaw-dropping top price of a whopping £1620, achieved by P and C Kynaston. This incredible figure set a high bar and showcased the exceptional quality and value of the Cattle presented.

Store Heifers:

The Store Heifers section was a standout feature of the sale, with a robust turnout of 78 heads. The strong competition in this category underscored the high market demand for these animals, reflecting the success of the sale. The Heifers category truly shone at our sale, with I J Faulkner & Son leading the way. They achieved an astounding top price per kilo of 289.8ppk, setting a new benchmark and underscoring superior care and management practices. This remarkable price per kilo was a testament to the high standards maintained by I J Faulkner & Son.

In addition to achieving the top ppk, I J Faulkner & Son secured the highest price per head in this category, making an outstanding £1610. This exceptional achievement highlights the quality of their Heifers and their ability to effectively meet market demands. The average price for Store Heifers was £1137 per head, showcasing the strong market performance and the high value placed on these animals. This average was just under £50 behind the steers, indicating a competitive and thriving market for Store Heifers.

The sale was a resounding success, with the Store Heifers category standing out as a key highlight. The excellent results reflect the hard work and dedication of the Sellers.

Store Bulls:

The Store Bulls category was highly competitive in our recent Sale, featuring a reduced entry of 10 heads. Despite the smaller number, the Bulls exhibited strong market presence and drew robust bidding activity. With an average price of 233.97 ppk and £923 per head, these Bulls demonstrated their quality and value to Buyers.

Bulls from R Allcock stood out prominently in this category, attracting significant interest and commanding competitive bids. They achieved an impressive top price per kilo of 327.3 ppk, reflecting their exceptional build and market appeal.

Additionally, R Allcock secured the highest price per head in this category, reaching £1260, reaffirming the premium quality and demand for their Bulls.

While the entry size was smaller than other categories, the Store Bulls maintained strong market competitiveness and achieved commendable prices. The sale highlighted the resilience and quality of the Bulls offered, setting a positive tone for future sales. We anticipate continued interest and demand for top-quality Store Bulls in upcoming Auctions bolstered by the success seen in this recent sale.

Feeding Cows:

Feeding Cows were presented in our recent sale, totalling 4 heads. Despite their smaller number, these Cows garnered significant interest and competitive bidding. The average price per kilo was 173.54 ppk, reflecting their quality and suitability for feeding purposes. The top price per kilo reached an impressive 196.40 ppk, highlighting the premium quality of select Cows. SR Edwards secured the highest price per head in this category, achieving £1090, underscoring the strong demand and value placed on these animals. Feeding Cows averaged £820 per head, demonstrating their market appeal and competitive pricing.
