



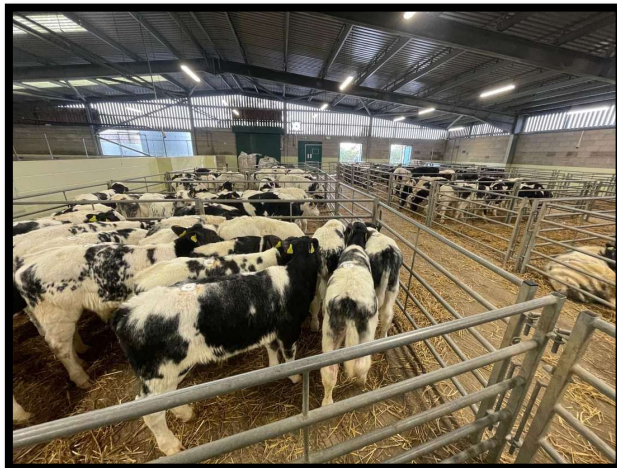

Williams and Partners, Lower farm followed by 193ppk / £1,462.94 for another belting sized Friesian over 750kgs, 8yrs old from S. E. Roberts, Beechfield Farm. Another Massive Aberdeen Angus Cow weighing 780kgs to 181ppk / £1,411.80 from L. J. Joseph, Tan-Y-Bryn.

A somewhat lively Limousin Cow flew through the ring at 177ppk / £1,093.86 from H. W. & S. M. Tuffin, Lower Cothecott.

A great entry this week with an abundance of buyers ringside.

Our full support goes to all those representing the farming fraternity down in London today, as we continue to keep the wheels turning.

The day's top price came from G Potter & Son, who sold a fantastic blue bull at £485, for a 2mo stormer, next inline was Bowdler, who had a great run topping at £420 and others at £406 and £402.

Any abundance of blue bulls between £360-£400, with an average of £300, all through. A great trio of Charolais from P Lloyd sold to £382 with others at £360 and £355.

Hereford bulls sold to £250 from S Ford & Son, while Limousins from S Hillage & Son sold to £280.

Friesians remain a good trade, topping at £200 on a couple of occasions with several smaller sorts £60-80.

Heifers held recent values very well with R Bowdler selling the best at £350 and £330, both for blues, while Bowdler Farms weighed in similar sorts at £324 and £318, with 10 trading £300 +.

Limousin Heifers sold to £255 from S Hillage & Son, with natives to £202 for Herefords from Cefn Coed Farms and Angus to £220 from Lower Shadymoor.

The Prime Lamb Sale at Shrewsbury Auction Centre on November 19, 2024, reaffirmed the strength of the lamb trade, with robust demand and excellent prices across all weight categories. Despite a reduced entry of 480 lambs, down from 621 last week, due to adverse weather conditions, the sale showcased the market's resilience. Buyers in attendance demonstrated strong competition for quality lambs, resulting in notable increases in the average price and SQQ.

This week's overall market average climbed to 300p/kg, a clear improvement from last week's 292p/kg and the 278p/kg seen on November 12. Similarly, the SQQ average increased to 302p/kg from 296p/kg last week, reflecting an upward trend in demand for well-finished lambs. These figures underscore the ongoing appetite for quality entries and the rewards vendors can achieve by presenting lambs with excellent finish and conformation.

The medium-weight lambs (39.1–45.5kg) stood out again this week, averaging 300p/kg, a solid jump from last week's 293p/kg. The top price per kilogram reached an impressive 334p/kg for a KH & RHO Harding pen, showing that quality lambs in this weight range are still highly sought after. On a per-head basis, the top price hit £138, with Bowdler Farms LTD securing that top spot, while the overall average per head came in at £127. This increase in price shows just how much demand there is for these medium-weight lambs, which are considered the sweet spot for buyers. They offer a great balance of size and finish, keeping them in high weekly demand. It's clear that buyers are looking for these types of lambs and are willing to pay well for them, and the market seems to be holding steady with strong interest continuing.

Standard-weight lambs (32.1–39kg) saw a strong trade this week, averaging 307p/kg, an increase from last week's 301p/kg. The top price per kilogram was an impressive 328p/kg, achieved by FM & SA Thomas & Son, while P Williams led the top price per head at £126. This category continues to attract premium prices, reflecting the strong buyer demand for lambs with exceptional finish and conformation. Compared to last week, the improvement in trade highlights the growing confidence in the market, with vendors rewarded for presenting quality stock. This weight class remains highly sought after, offering vendors an excellent opportunity to capitalise on competitive bidding.

Heavy lambs (45.6–52kg) continued their impressive run, averaging 297p/kg, an increase from last week's 290p/kg. IR Edge consigned the top pen in this category, reaching 307p/kg, with Bowdler Farms LTD achieving the top per-head price of £151.50. These figures highlight the sustained demand for lambs offering a high meat yield, rewarding vendors who bring forward entries with superior finish and carcass quality.

In the 52kg+ category, demand remained solid, with an average of 270p/kg compared to last week's 281p/kg. The top price per kilogram was 281p/kg, achieved by RM Taylor & Sons, with the highest price per head at £160, achieved by IR Edge. While fewer in number, heavy lambs continue to attract interest, particularly for well-finished entries.

Looking back at the November 12th sale, where 621 lambs were offered, this week's trade further strengthened prices. The continued success of the Tuesday store lamb section has been a key factor in ensuring a consistently high-quality offering in the prime lamb section. By redirecting unfinished lambs to the store section, vendors are helping to maintain buyer confidence and achieve top-tier prices for finished stock. The trade remains buoyant, with plenty of scope for increased numbers. Buyers are actively seeking more lambs to meet ongoing demand, with several commenting that the yard could easily have handled upwards of 1,000 entries this week. Vendors are encouraged to take advantage of this thriving market by adding additional entries in the coming weeks.

The store lamb section at Shrewsbury Auction Centre on November 19, 2024, welcomed a smaller entry of 85 lambs, down from 254 the previous week. The market maintained strong momentum despite the reduced numbers, with robust buyer demand and firm prices across all categories. The average price per head for store lambs rose to £88, a £0.50 increase on last week's £87.50, continuing the upward trend in recent weeks.

This week's top price of £110 was achieved by KJ & TMC Llewellyn, which was indicative of strong competition for quality lambs. Other leading prices included £102 from AW Jones and £96 from CE Rowley, showcasing consistent demand across the entry. Ewe lambs averaged £93.50 per head, with RM Dolley securing the top price in this section at £93.50, underscoring the appeal of well-bred, correctly finished stock.

Compared to the November 12 sale, last week's larger entry saw stronger top-end prices due to the inclusion of several standout pens of well-finished lambs. However, this week's trade showed buyers remained active and competitive despite the smaller numbers, with many leaving wishing for more lambs to bid on. The smaller entry likely reflects the adverse weather, with heavy snowfall affecting farm transport. Nonetheless, the diverse offering of short-, medium-, and long-term lambs ensured that there was something for every buyer, keeping the trade buoyant.

Buyers praised the variety of lambs forward this week, particularly those suited for future grazing or finishing, which maintained steady interest. While this week's top prices were slightly lower than last week's peaks, the average price across the board remained firm, driven by consistent buyer confidence in the quality of lambs.

The shift to a Tuesday sale continues to succeed, enabling vendors and buyers to better align their schedules and preferences. With demand for store lambs remaining high, vendors are encouraged to increase entries in the coming weeks, especially given the market's ability to absorb larger numbers.
