Cows a flyer starting from £1400 they peaked at £2850 for the pick of 2 glorious cows from Millenheath Farms Ltd, she was **MILLENHEATH FLEX SHREW GP83** Fresh in her second giving 45kg a day, she was closely followed by her herd mate **MILLENHEATH AMULET JANIE VG85** Who sold giving 52kg a day for an impressive £2800. The pick of the Meldamar Team was **MELDAMAR REDCARPET HEATHER 64** she was giving 45kg a day and achieved £2600 a noteworthy £2300 was achieved by a 4th lactation brown Swiss cow from H Davies & Partners, Puddington.

In the heifers the quality was good... but I'm sure there have been a few held back for next week as prices peaked at £2720 for **PENDYFFRYN TROPIC EMPRESS** presented by Mark Hughes giving 30kg a day. First in the market was PB Sutton & Partners from Atherstone and their reward for coming to shrews was £2680 for a jet-black cow making heifer **HIURCOTT ADORABLE PANDORA 42TH** who was giving 34kg a day, another from this good home achieved £2500. A superb team of 5 heifers today from Mick Gould sold from £2280 to £2550 for **WOODMARSH TOTEM MELODY** who which 10 generations of VG & EX dams sold to a pedigree enthusiast from Whitchurch. Only 4 heifers sold for under £2000, either crossbreds or those with faults.

A smart run of high-quality bulling heifers from P Hill & Son, Hydaways Holsteins graces our ring today. It is sold reassuring to see youngstock in demand, for too long they have not realised their worth until freshly calves. But today prices hit £1020 for **HYDAWAYS MILANO BEATTIE** a 15mo heifer with a 5 generation VG & EX Pedigree, and £1000 for **HYDAWAYS WILLOWS JEANETTE** an 18mo Heifer with an outstanding pedigree from the Linlake Jeanette family.

Limousin X Cows topped at 213ppk / £1,495.26 for a weighty 9yr old cow from M. C. & W. C. Boston & Higgins, Walford Smallholding.

Older, weightier Aberdeen Angus Cows from J. S. Latham, Newton Hall Dispersal reached 197ppk / £1,260.80 for a 9yr old weighing 640kg.

A Cracking British Blue X Cow also from M. T. Lewis & Son, Woodside Farm, 3yrs old made 196ppk / £1,172.08.

Friesians Ranged from 148 – 186ppk

Topping at 186ppk / £1,476.84 for a 7yr old from M. Chesters, Severnside Milkers Ltd who also had Friesians at 176ppk and 148ppk.

A phenomenal trade on all classes of calves today with an abundance of eager buyers ringside. The days leading lights came from TM Pain with Charolais bull at £450, along with several blue bulls close behind. JR Paddock sold blue bulls to £448 and £430 with Bowdler Farms selling to £446.

Limousin Bulls from R Hillage traded to £420 with several others £400 +. All blue bulls averaged £326 with the best of the natives to £260 for Herefords and £200 for Angus.

Simmentals were well represented today averaging £356 to a high of £458 for a good run from SHB Summers.

Friesians' bulls still a very good trade although perhaps not a clear as we have seen selling to £188 and averaging £81. Heifers another fantastic price to a high of £430 for a Blue from FG & AM Windsor, with the best of the run to £340 from Bowdler Farms Ltd, while Tony Wilson sold his good run to £315, all blue females sold to average £255 while Charolais sold to £280 from P Lloyd. A good run from A & I Crowther saw their heifers to £275 and £265.

Our Christmas calf auction takes place next week with classes as above. Do please support the sale and come along for a glass of mulled wine and a mince Pie. It would be great to see a good crowd at Shrewsbury.

The Prime Lamb Sale at Shrewsbury Auction Centre on December 3, 2024, welcomed 565 spring lambs, a decrease from last week's larger entry of 832. Despite the smaller numbers, the market remained steady, with buyers competing to secure quality lambs ahead of Christmas. The overall market average settled at 301p/kg, slightly down from 305p/kg last week, while the SQQ was recorded at 302p/kg. These figures reflect the resilience of the trade, buoyed by consistent demand for well-finished stock, though fewer entries slightly softened the top-end prices.

In the 25.5–32kg range, 24 lambs averaged 297p/kg, with a top price of 310p/kg achieved by J Hotchkiss & Son. RS Smith secured the highest price per head at £95. This category saw two pens exceed 300p/kg, underscoring the strong demand for well-finished lambs in this weight range. While representing a smaller segment of the sale, these lighter carcasses continue to attract buyers. This week's trade held firm, comparable to last week's 280p/kg average, reaffirming the value of well-prepared entries in maintaining competitive prices.

Standard-weight lambs (32.1–39kg) performed steadily this week, with 157 entries averaging 303p/kg, a slight dip from last week's 306p/kg. F & SM Scholfield led the trade, achieving a top price of 329p/kg and securing the highest price per head at £128.50. This category continued to attract strong buyer interest, with nine pens surpassing 300p/kg and 15 exceeding 290p/kg, demonstrating the ongoing demand for lambs with exceptional finish and conformation. Despite a smaller entry than last week's 170 lambs, this segment remains a reliable vendor option, consistently rewarding quality stock. The average per head across this weight range stood at an impressive £112.

Medium-weight lambs (39.1–45.5kg) once again dominated the sale, making up 309 of the 565 lambs on offer. Averaging 302p/kg, this category saw a slight dip from last week's 308p/kg, but demand remained strong throughout. D Penlington achieved the top price per kilogram at 316p/kg, while JH Jones & Son secured the highest price per head at £137. With over half of the day's entries in this weight range, medium-weight lambs continue to be the backbone of the sale, offering vendors an excellent balance of

volume and price. Competition was fierce, with 25 pens selling for over 300p/kg, highlighting the sustained demand for these well-finished lambs. There is a clear appetite for more quality lambs next week, particularly those with strong meat content.

Heavy lambs (45.6–52kg) saw 70 entries this week, averaging 298p/kg, a slight dip from last week's 304p/kg. KJ & TM Llewelyn led the category with a top price of 304p/kg, while TER & JA Pryce secured the highest price per head at £154. While demand for heavy lambs remains steady due to their higher meat yields, this week's fewer entries likely limited the top-end competition seen in previous sales. Only 6

pens sold for over 300p/kg, reflecting a shift in trade since the summer, with somewhat reduced demand for these heavier weights. However, they still attract interest from buyers looking for lambs that can deliver a substantial return.

This week, just five entries were in the super-heavy category for lambs over 52kg. This limited entry averaged 274p/kg, with JMP Thomas achieving the top price of 292p/kg and J Higgins & Son securing the highest price per head at £161. While fewer in number, these larger lambs continue to attract interest from buyers seeking big carcasses for specific orders.

Compared to last week's sale, which benefitted from an increased entry and robust pre-Christmas demand, this week's market showcased a stable yet slightly subdued trade. Last week's overall market average of 305p/kg and SQQ of 306p/kg set a high bar, but the reduced numbers this week held their own, particularly in the medium and standard-weight categories. The consistent upward trajectory over recent weeks, from 292p/kg three weeks ago to 305p/kg last week, underlines the strength of the current trade.

Buyers once again emphasised their capacity to handle significantly larger entries, with several noting that the yard could have easily managed over 1,000 lambs. Vendors are encouraged to capitalise on the market's robust demand by increasing entries in the coming weeks. The cull ewe and ram trade at Shrewsbury Auction Centre on December 3, 2024, saw 370 cull ewes and 19 cull rams forward. This was a slight reduction from last week's sale, where 403 cull ewes and 15 rams were presented, marking a significant increase in numbers compared to the 284 cull ewes and 2 rams offered on November 19 due to weather disruptions. This week, the market for cull ewes saw a slight dip in average price, with cull ewes averaging £88, compared to last week's £132, but this largely reflects the different quality and types of stock forward. The presence of many plainer ewes this week, with fewer well-finished, heavy ewes, caused the overall average to drop. However, demand for better-quality stock remained high, reflecting top prices. The top price for cull ewes this week was £179 for a Suffolk cross from RT Edwards & Son, with other high prices of £161 and £160 also achieved for Suffolk crosses. This compares to last week's top of £259 for a pure Texel from RE & CJ Davies, a significant rise from the £143.50 achieved for J Pugh's top ewe in the prior sale. Last week saw a strong price surge, with better-quality, well-meated ewes commanding substantial prices, and the continued demand for heavy, meaty ewes remains evident. Despite the overall drop in average price this week, the strong demand for good-quality stock remains.

In the cull ram section, 19 rams were sold this week, up from 15 last week. The average price for cull rams was £110, with a top price of £160 for a Dutch Spotted ram from S Greig. This solid result is similar to last week's top price of £170. This week's stronger entry is a positive sign, and buyers continue to seek quality rams for slaughter and breeding, particularly those in good condition.

While this week's trade saw fewer top-end prices than last week, the demand for quality stock remains strong, and the market continues to show resilience. With Christmas approaching, demand for cull ewes and rams is expected to stay high. Vendors are encouraged to bring more stock forward in the coming weeks to exploit the strong buyer interest. There is a clear need for more heavy, meaty ewes and well-conditioned rams to meet ongoing demand. The store lamb sale at Shrewsbury Auction Centre on December 3, 2024, saw 121 lambs forward, with a solid average price per head of £103. This marked a £5 increase per head from the previous sale on November 26, 2024, when 211 store lambs averaged £98.

The price increase reflects the continued demand for store lambs as buyers compete for stock in the lead-up to Christmas. The top price of £113 per head was achieved by BPH Llewelyn, with N Johns close behind at £110. Other notable prices included £109 from RJ Wilding and £107.50 from KJ & TMC Llewelyn, underscoring the strong competition. This week's trade was again marked by a wide range of buyers, with many leaving the sale with half loads, highlighting the strong demand for store lambs. While the entry was smaller than the 211 lambs offered the week before, the demand was just as evident. There were also plenty of opportunities for vendors to achieve high prices, with the higher-quality lambs continuing to secure premiums. The demand for well-finished and medium-term lambs remains healthy, and despite a smaller entry, there was keen competition for all types.

This week's sale saw a more varied selection of lambs, with buyers looking for short- and long-term grazing options. The £5 per head increase compared to last week further illustrates the ongoing demand in the store lamb market. Although the number of lambs offered was lower, the demand remains high, with many buyers indicating that they would have purchased more had additional lambs been available. With Christmas approaching, the store lamb market remains strong, and vendors are encouraged to bring forward more lambs in the coming weeks to meet the high buyer interest. Looking ahead, the store lamb market at Shrewsbury is expected to stay robust, particularly as we move into the winter months and demand for lambs increases. The continued support from buyers looking for quality stock for grazing and finishing ensures that this section of the sale will remain an important and competitive marketplace.

A ROARING TRADE, bids from all over the ringside and gallery from the very first to the very last in the ring double the number could easily have been sold with buyers travelling from as far as somerset to be attendance

The sale commenced with the Dispersal of the Oldcastle Herd of Pedigree Aberdeen Angus on behalf of J S Latham of Malpas which were exclusively grass fed these outfits were split with the best cows to 1340gns for Oldcastle Poppet S707 while the best Calves off the dams peaked at 810gns on numerous occasions for Bull Calves born in late April and May.

In the weanling the bulls got the trade off to a flying start peaking at £985 for a 7mo Limousin from LA & DL Brown, Stabilisers to £905 for TL Walker & Co, Angus from the same home £900. A 7mo Simmental out of a dairy cow to £830 HP Price & Sons while blues peaked at £780 for PB Suttons from Warwickshire. Holstein Bulls sold to £490 at 6mo for James Dale & Co of Binweston
