The sale topper was the sensational MELDARMAR MEDALIST VOGUE, FROM Messrs JM & D Shepherd she was giving 31kg per day, closely followed in the prices another beauty from the same home **MELDARMAR DARWIN DIANA 81** who was giving 38kg achieved £3550. A single cow from the same home also topped that section at £3300, well done to the shepherds on the superb run of fresh cattle today. Selling at £3500 was a beautiful heifer from messrs T & R Gleave of Chester which rocketed to £3500 with a daughter of Denovo Charter, and 1st time vendor EG & AM Edwards and a super £3100 for their heifer **BWLCHYCIBAU ATLANTIS DAWN HB.**

A tremendous 2nd calved cow from FG Windsor and sons back by a 9 generation pedigree **HENDOMEN ARLENE 151 GP83** achieved £3150 only 12 days calved giving 33kg and rising, other smart young cows from £2220 to £2650.

A run of mixed cross bred dry cows from Shotton Dairies met a strong demand for the Holstein and British Friesian Types peaking at £2520 for **PIMHILL CAMARO CHRISTINE** who was due with her 4th calf a British Blue, at the end of August, another due with her 5th sold for £2350, Danish imports born in 202 sold for £2350 and £1800. Crossbred saw bidding upto £1700 and ¾ cows £1480, a very good level of demand.

A superb entry of 1,400 Spring Lambs was forward this week at Shrewsbury, with strong numbers and excellent quality resulting in a solid and consistent trade throughout the sale. There was particularly strong demand for well-finished, fleshy lambs, while leaner types proved harder to place. With the current trade favouring heavier lambs, it certainly pays to finish lambs properly before marketing. Heavier lambs attracted the keenest demand and the best prices on the day.

Top price per kilo was had for a pen of lambs from A. Cockayne, Springs Cottage up to 366ppk and then to £190 for a trio from C. Harding, Elm Farm.

A superb run of Cows and Calves from T. L. Walker & Co, Rowdale Farm saw a brilliant top price of £3,550 for an 8yr old British Blue Cow with 3month old LIM X Bull calf at foot followed by a 7yr old Stabilizer cow with a 3month old Charolais X Heifer calf at foot reaching £2,650 as well as a beautiful young 3yr old Hereford cow and 6month old Bull Calf at foot from P & E Williams, The Oaks selling for £2,300.

A Fantastic 3yr old Pedigree Hereford Bull, Vexour 1 William from Messrs S. M. & C. M. Ashley, Upper Cothercott Farm sold to a whopping £3,200 through the ring going to a good home down near Ludlow.
