A smaller entry of calves this week sold to a much-improved trade with a good mix of breeds on offer. Leading the trade in the young calves were a trio of tremendous Charolais Bull Calves from CT Pain, all just under 1 month old selling for £610, £600 and £595. Next in the prices was the pick on the blues today from Richard Bowdler that sold for £585. At £565 was a 6week old blue from James Harrison, The Pymys. The

nice shaped blues from £400-500, but there were some smaller plainer calves to be snapped up under the £300 mark. Some Smart Limousins about to £470 for J & R Corfield, £465 for ME & RA Sadler Angus Bulls peaked at £410 for a Cracking sort from JF & AA Owen of Overton, and £365 for Dave Everall. Herefords topped at £390 for M Chesters strong calf, young fresh Hereford bulls from WF Lees selling up to £375.

Heifer calves peaked at £495 for a sweet Cow making Blue from Richard Bowdler plenty of customers for well-presented blue heifers today and more could have easily been sold to the vendor's advantage. Limousins from John Phillips only 15days old up to £390 with a strong angus heifer from Hannah Edwards selling for £330, with typical angus heifers over the £200 mark

Black and whites to 310 for a 8wo calve from G& M Lewis, a young 22-day old Holstein from John Phillips £200. Small processing type Holstein bulls started from £32.
