A WONDERFUL ENTRY FOR THE FINAL SALE BEFORE THE CHIRSTMAS CRACKER NEXT WEEK. Thank you to all the vendors and buyers that turned out and we look forward to welcoming you again for the hotly contested Bryan Challenor Cup!

A mixed line up of cows today with 7 Holstein types selling for over £2100 to a peak of £3150 and 9 grazing Friesian and Norwegian Reds which sold up to £930. Top of the show was a wonderful cow from JM & D Shepherd of Bakewell with **MELDARMAR ADORABLE DREAM 158** a 2nd calved cow producing 54 litres at 5.49%bf!! Next best seller was **MELDAMAR APPS LADY RUTH**, who sold for £2700, a 4th Calver from AC & DC Drinkall met strong bidding to level at £2650.

Onto the heifers and demand was very strong from the start with the first heifer in the ring selling for £3420, she was a Bomaz Episode from T& R Gleave of Warrington. The top price on the day of £3450 was seen twice, firstly for Tony Scott with **LEAFIELDS ORTHLID PAULINE**, and secondly for Guto Lewis with **LISCABANK LEVEL JEN MOLLY 4** 2 wonderful heifers gents. Also cracking the £3000 barrier was Mark Hughes with **FLAGG LETSGO RAVEN**, she was just some machine eventually selling for £3300, Mark also had a commercial bred heifer at £3100. Well balances uniform Heifers effortlessly selling for £2500+ but I think there was a slightly more selective ringside with small imperfections making a difference.

In Calf heifers due in the new year and into the spring sold to £1450 for G Dutton.

Next week is the Bryan Challenor Cup, we look forward to welcoming clients old and new to the ringside for a busy and festive days trading!

Numbers tight this morning and trade electric. Some strength forward sold to an eye watering £1020 on two occasions both for Limousin bulls at 7 weeks! Similar aged calves to £1000 again from Tim James, Llandrinio. Some lovely Blue bulls forward selling to £800 from PA & JM Astley, with Richard Bowdler in hot pursuit at £780, with Clare David selling her best to £745. A great trade for some great

calves. All blue bulls averaged a phenomenal £528. A reared Angus bull from DR James sold to £950, with another at £820 while a 4 week corker from MN Edwards sold to £622. Hereford bulls sold to £460 while a great run of Charolais bulls from David Evans sold to a peak of £650. Friesians again on fire with the best baby calves to £295 from Roger Ainsworth with Ms Ankers selling to £188!

Strength in the heifers saw a packet of strong Angus at 2 months sell to an astonishing £855 while Charolais from David Evans sold to £650 and Blues from Richard Bowdler to £550. Plenty of trade for the best with them as dear as we have seen for a while. That trade follows through the line with the plainer sorts seeing a significant lift!

Now is most definitely a great time to market calves with plenty of demand throughout. How can you value them at home based on this trade. Please get in touch for any advice.

THE JOB IS TREMENDOUS, a wonderful entry for the end of November with a packed ringside of buyers from the word go trade was flying throughout.

The suckler bred commanding the top prices as is expected at this time of year with 5mo Charolais Bulls from SI & ML Griffiths selling for £1360 (2) & £1300 (2) again 5mo Salers from Farm & Forest £1260 (5). Suckler Steers Raced away to £1800 for a yearling Simmental Bullock from KR & WRJ Williams, a 10mo Simmental from JR Payne also ticking the boxes at £1780. 7Mo Charolais Steers topped at £1290 for S Evans of Stiperstones, heifers from the same home sold for £1330, into the native breeds and a pen of 6 April born Hereford Steers from Crows Agricultural sold for £980.

Dairy Bred sorts were again in great demand from the outset, the smaller they were the dearer they sold, with Angus Bulls just weanling from DR James, Llandrinio fetching £1000, Limousin Heifers from the same home at £1000, 8mo Blue bulls to £1380 for GH Barker, Ditton Priors. Blue Steers 11mo from RT Tudor romped to £1440 (5), the same money seen for a yearling Limousin from Brian Price, a consignment of 45 from Reaseheath College Nantwich were well received peaking at £1320 for 11mo Hereford Steers, in to the heifers and Blues 9mo sold to £1320 for RW Adams & Son, a pen of 10mo Limousin Heifers from RT Tudor an impressive £1280. Angus from Reaseheath to £1200.

There were plenty of younger weanlings just off the milk today as well and my god didn't, they sell well! Longhorn bulls 4mo from James Dale to £620, Longhorn Heifers form the same home £640. 4mo Angus Heifers again from the same home £720!! 5mo Blue Steer from Mycocks Agri Derbyshire £1010, Heifers £860, A 5mo Brown Swiss bull £530 for Toi Toi Genetics.
