3. Halls Holdings Limited reserves the right to withhold the VAT refund until all necessary export verification documents have been received and verified.

If the purchaser fails to provide the required documentation, Halls Holdings Limited will retain VAT, and no refund will be issued.

This condition will be strictly adhered to without exception.

Exporting to Northern / Southern Ireland

Any purchasers exporting from the UK to Northern or Southern Ireland are solely responsible for the Northern Ireland Plant Health Label and Phytosanitary Certificate needed to export out of the UK.

New Purchasers and Conditions of Payment

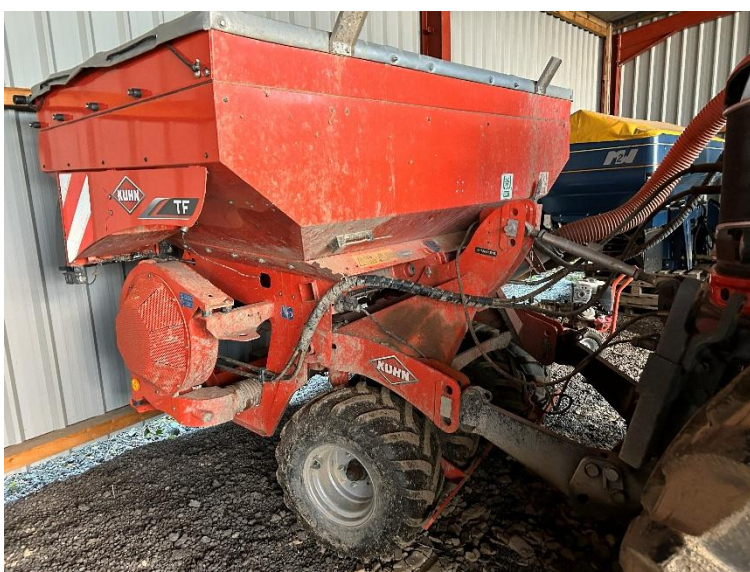

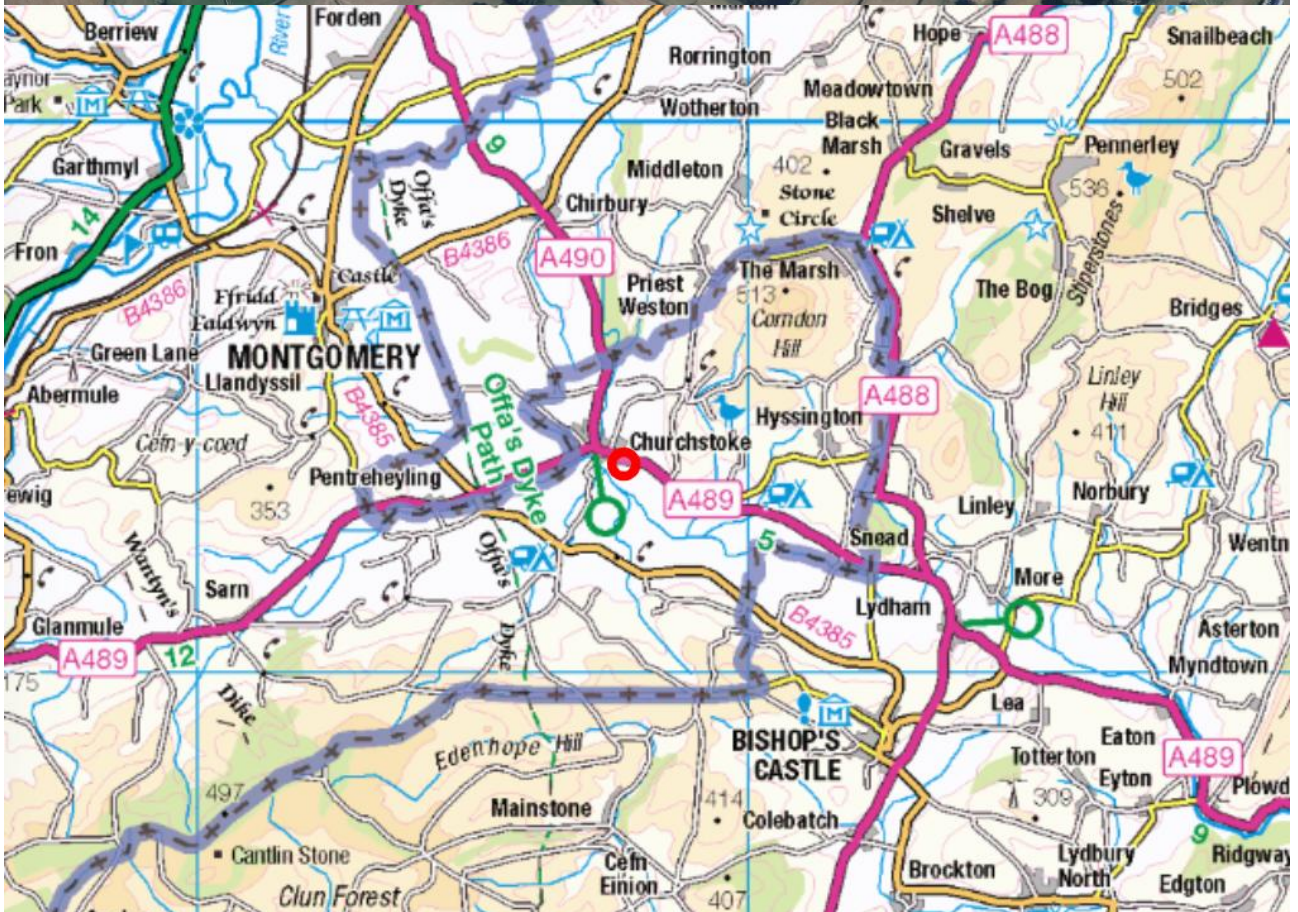
