

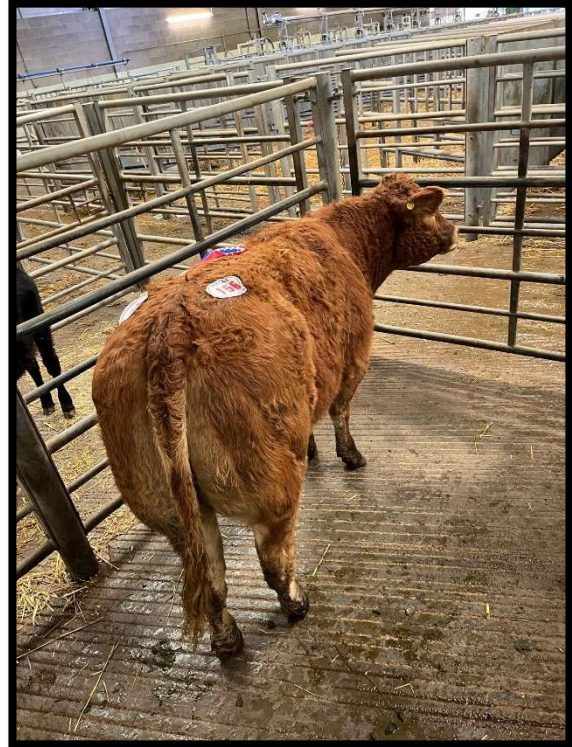
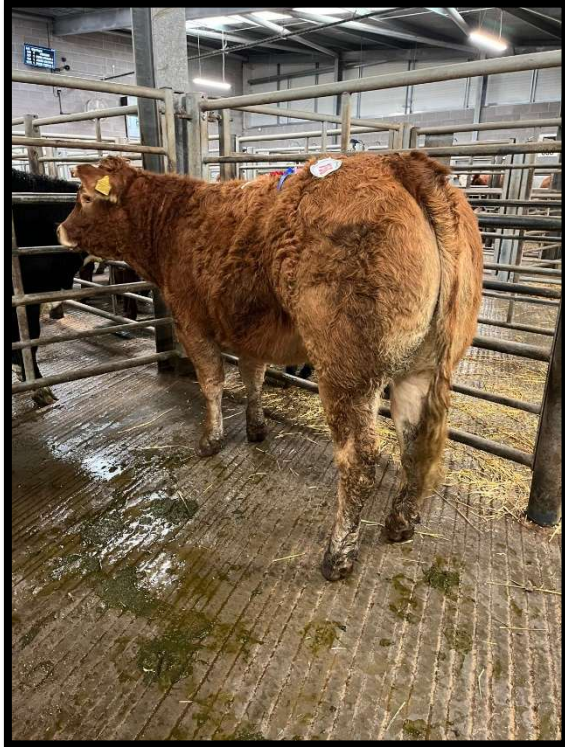

No question today the quality was overall was not at the level of the previous 2 weeks with more light, 2nd Quality types on offer which makes the average for both calves and heifers all the more impressive!!

Top price on the day when for a wonderful 2nd calved cow from JM & D Shepherd and Sons of Bakewell with **MELDAMAR FITZ LISA 159** giving 48kg she was a picture and flew to £3420, she was followed in the prices at £3200 for a typical youthful balanced from RB Evans & Son **GLANWRCH AMPLIFY CLEO VG85** in her 3rd lactation giving 35Kg also hitting the £3000 barrier was **WOLSTON HANGTIME SOPHIE 11** from AD & RM Thomas of Lutterworth.

Into the heifers and it was again RM & AD Thomas with their pair of heifers both achieving £3350 firstly for **WOLSTON GRANITE GLACE 96** who was giving 36, and **WOLSTON DREAMBIG AMANDA** who was giving 35kg. Next in the prices was the returning JG Morgan of Tewksbury with **LANOVER TAOS GRACINE**, a jet-black heifer I really liked and sold for £3250! Malcolm Trevor Jones Pick today in the heifers sold for £3050 as new vendor N & K Brown's 35kg Heifer **DUNSTALLHALL NB MEGASTAR TATTY**, a true milk machine sold for £3000. Any number of correct heifers from £2850-£2950, and not just with Holsteins a Montbéliard x from RT Albert sold at £2950, Probably the most talked about heifer on the day was the glorious Norwegian Red x Jersey from Lomas Farming Company, Tarvin small but perfectly formed she sold for £2250.

Decent numbers penned this morning and what a great feeling it was around the ring with a return to normality. With no hard border for trade. We welcomed plenty of welsh buyers back to Shrewsbury and helped drive the trade up in all sections. Blue bulls sold to £685 from R Bowdler Ltd and to £682 from Bowdler Farms, with Harrison Farms selling to £672. All the bulls averaged

£475 with 10 selling in excess of £600. Limousins bulls sold to £590 from Messrs David, Braggington, with PT Stinton also selling to £590, with J Corfield close behind at £575.

Simmental bulls to £550 from CJ Tams with Charolais bulls to £506 from Mesr Beddoes.

Natives topped at £518 for Angus from Messrs Dale with Herefords to £395 for H Stubbs. Even the Friesians were a storming trade selling to £295 for the best of a run from Mesr Dale.

Heifers topped at £598 from JR Paddock for a lovely blue with another from R Bowdler Ltd selling to £592. 10 Blue heifers trade £550 + with all averaging £399.

Simmental x Heifers to £500, Limousins to £460 with Herefords to £450 from T Morgan.

Trade on the females sold as well as the bulls, with the best sorts commanding a serious premium.

Overall, a serious trade on all on offer. 100+ more calves could easily have been sold with buyers looking for numbers.

A total of **410 spring lambs** were sold, averaging a strong **317p/kg overall** and **320p/kg SQQ**. Competition was spirited across all weight ranges, resulting in excellent returns and proving once again that quality always sells.

Top of the day went to **K.M. & C.M. Atkin**, achieving an impressive **361p/kg**. **P.W. Poole of Beaconsfield Farm** led the way on price per head, realising a superb **£222 for a 108kg lamb**. Congratulations to both for showcasing outstanding stock that rightly drew attention from the buyers.

The lighter lambs were also in strong demand, peaking at **347p/kg** and averaging **301p/kg**, while the **32-39kg section** was particularly sharp, topping at **361p/kg (£136.50)** and averaging **329p/kg (£118)**. **Medium weights (40-45kg)** averaged **317p/kg (£133)**, reaching highs of **349p/kg (£150)**. **Heavier lambs (46-51kg)** maintained confidence in the trade, averaging **312p/kg (£150)** and topping at **327p/kg (£159)**.

The **super heavyweights (52kg+)** rounded off proceedings nicely, averaging **£167 per head** and peaking at **£222**.

With the **Prime NSL SQQ at 320p/kg** and the **overall NSL average at 317p/kg**, the day reflected a consistent and competitive trade from start to finish.

While this week's entry was smaller than usual for the time of year, vendors can take confidence in the fact that **Shrewsbury Livestock Market is well equipped to handle over 1,000 lambs weekly**. With Christmas trade fast approaching and buyers eager to fill orders, now is an excellent time to bring forward well-finished lambs.

A smaller seasonal entry of **cull ewes and rams** met with a strong and competitive trade once again this week, with all classes finding buyers and plenty of interest around the ring.

A total of **343 ewes and rams** were sold, averaging **£85.89 per head** overall.

The average reflected the fact that around **90% of the ewes forward were of plain type or hill-bred**, yet trade remained lively throughout. Stronger, meatier sorts were noticeably scarce, and with buyers keen for well-fleshed ewes, there's clear potential for **more fat crossbred ewes** to be rewarded with an excellent return in the coming weeks.

Ewes topped at a fantastic **£192** from **S.C. Pearce**, while the section averaged **£84.73**, a solid result given the plainer entry.

Killing rams sold to **£210** from Messrs Macdonald, averaging **£124.54** for a tidy pen of heavy sorts.

Buyers were active across all classes, ensuring that even the leaner and hill-bred ewes met a firm demand.

Once again, this week's smaller seasonal entry was well supported, and vendors can take confidence knowing that **Shrewsbury Livestock Market is fully equipped to handle larger entries as we move into the winter months**.

The job was tremendous, and the smaller they were the dearer they went, HW & SM Tuffin Limousin Bulls 7mo straight off the cow £1560, Dobson the Walls 6-8mo Stabiliser £1400 to £1580 pen after pen with their 3/4mo Stabiliser bulls at £1320! The top price raced away to £2120 for a 10mo Simmental Bull from TS & C Powell 5mo Hereford Bulls from Mrs J Roberts blew my mind at £1360. Into the dairy Breds and 4mo Limousins to £680 for Toi Toi Genetics, 5mo Herefords to £680 for A Garlick. More could easily be sold to vendor's advantage!

The Steers just Flew today with the champion pen of 8mo Simmentals from KA & AS Litter topping the sale at a well-deserved £1570, other sucklers to £1480 for pair of Herefords 9mo from JT Frank, 7mo Angus from April Goodier £1400. 7mo Blondes to £1400 for SA & EA Ackerley 5mos from the same home to £1240. South Devons to £1380 7mo from DB & ES Jones, Limousins 9mo to £1360 for S & AV Richards. Not to be left behind were the Dairy Bred Steers peaking at £1500 for a 10mo Blue from B Chelmick, Angus to £1420 at 12mo from GG Unwin, an exceptional price for a lovely pen was £1310 for 7mo Blues from N L Ford.... Says something when I'm, not reporting a trade under £1300!!

The Heifers we like arguably the most sought after of the day and peaked at £1800 for a champion pedigree Limousin from RW Humphreys of the Pwll, His reserve champion 7mo Heifer achieved £1540, a pair from the same home £1520! Well done ray on a fantastic team of calves this year!! They were only surpassed on the day by TS & C Powell's 16mo Simmental heifer at £2090. Blonde Heifers from SA & EA Ackerley 7mo sold to £1360 and stabiliser heifers from Messrs Dobson the Wall to £1080. But the pick of the trade was the tremendous £1380 achieved for 7mo Blue Heifers from Ian Roberts from Forden, his 5mo Blue Heifers sold to £1020! 5mo Hereford heifers out of grass-based cows, which had been outside from Annabelle Garlick sold to £600!
