What a day for the dairy. To start, a big thank you to the Manford Family and Staff for dispersal of the Jersey and Guernsey herd.

The weekly sale saw a good entry of quality heifers and cows. The top prices highlighted this: Fresh Heifers topped at £3750 and Fresh Cows topped at £3200.

D N James & Co topped the cows with their entry, **MEADOWFORT COPYCST CUTIE 38**. This 2nd calver had great style, she was closely followed by the first cow in the ring. A homebred 3rd calver from J W & L Faux. **KENMAR APPLEJAX GABRIELLE GP84** calved just 8 days and was already smashing out 37kg and was still rising. She made £2700.

An outstanding entry of fresh heifers this week. With 32 coming forward and 12 of them making over £3000. This milk price drop didn't have a say in the sale today at all. P B and J Knight stole the sale with **NURSERYHILL SOLARPOWER TIPPY**, this flashy heifer backed by 9 generations of VG / EX topped the day at £3750. Just behind her was a lot 16 from A & C Drinkall. **HOCLEW VILLSNOVA ABBEY**, which was calved 7 days ago and gave 38kg, topped out at £3680. Just out of reach of her was a Pedigree heifer from G L L and E M Lewis. **LISCABANK BUSTER PAM 3**, calved on 9th November and was giving 32kg. She made £3650 and went to a local home in Shropshire. Commercial heifers topped at £3620 from A & C Drinkall. The weekly fresh heifer average was £2865.83.

A run of Pedigree In calf heifers from R B Evans & Son. **GLANIWRCH P FLORA** topped the run at £1400, she was back in calf to sexed semen due 21.03.2026. Then a run of Pedigree maiden heifers from EL LD DA Evans Topped at £1020 for **TILSTONE TYCE HEATHER**.

Don't forget our Christmas Show and Sale will be held on 2nd December for The Bryan Challenor Cup. Prize money to be won, so don't miss out on getting your entries in. The judge this year will be Mr Roberts Evans, Carmarthenshire.

A small reminder, on show and sale days, we are very busy, so to make sure everyone gets the same treatment on the wash and judging, please make sure to get your cattle in before 10 am.

The Twyfords Herd dispersal really highlighted the love of traditional breeds and the splash of colour wanted in herds.

54 heads came forward in the market, and the sale started with a bombshell. A fresh calved Guernsey x heifer reached £2500. The fresh heifers of the herd averaged £1835.

These sweet ladies just went above and beyond anyone's expectations. With a full crowd around the ring and multiple buyers on Marteye as well. The In Milk cows and Heifers, and due next spring, Aberdeen Angus calves. Topped at £1750 for a Jersey x seconded calver. We then moved on to the In calf heifers were the first to really start to show. Lot 145 Jersey x due December to the Aberdeen Angus Bull made £1500, and Guernsey x Heifer due the same time to the same bull made £1600. The overall average for the in-calf Heifers was £1287.50. The youngstock following in hot pursuit with jerseys topped at £1250 for a pair 7 month 7-month-old heifers. Maiden heifers averaged £845.45.

Aberdeen Angus X Cows to 207ppk / £1,121 from J. W. Hopley. Swiss Cows to 171ppk / £1,019 from J. A. Phillips & Son. Stabilizer Cows to 227ppk / £1,048 from C. J. & L. Tams. Similar numbers for us this week with trade again showing huge improvement of recent weeks. We really do welcome back the restricted buyers who we have been unable to trade with for several months. Trade back to fantastic levels with blue bulls heading the section at £750 from James Paddock, with TA Wainwright selling his usual quality blue bulls to £690, while similar calves

sold to £685 from Bowdler Farms. Several blue bulls £620-640 with these being well competed for all day. Angus bulls from Mark Edwards sailed to £550 with Charolais from Martin Lewis sold to £480 on two occasions. Some decent black and whites sold well to £400 for a 3-month bull with others to £270 and £240 on two occasions for proper sorts with trade electric on all Friesians, returning an average of £155. Heifers just as sharp with young blues to £575 from Richard Bowdler with Charolais from CT Pain to £572. Several blue heifers £480-£500 while the younger offering of native calves sold to £260 for a nice little Hereford from Martin Lewis. Plenty of trade across the board today, for whatever breed or strength. Please keep numbers up for next week!
