Crabtree Farm is situated at Cuddington on the outskirts of the village of Malpas which is approximately 10 miles north west of Whitchurch and 16 miles south of Chester

Take the A41 from Whitchurch and join the B5395 signposted Malpas. Before entering the village of Malpas take the left hand turn onto Mastiff Lane which continues on to Dog Lane. Continue on Dog Lane and take the right hand turn onto Crabtree Lane, continue for a short distance and the farmhouse will be found on the left hand side with farm buildings on the right hand side of the road.
