Conditions of Sale

Vendors are asked to either bring trailers of Fodder to the market for prospective purchasers to view and then take away after the sale, through negotiation OR bring a sample of the bales to be sold into the market to be parked up / placed in front of the doors to the main ring.

Inspection of all lots before the sale is advised and buyers will have one week after the sale to make the auctioneers aware of any queries before payment and collection.

All lots are sold per bale and the price at the fall of the hammer will be multiplied by the number of bales in the lot.

All bales are to be collected by the successful purchaser from the addresses provided in this listing via prior arrangement with the vendor using the telephone number provided.

All bales are sold 'Off the Stack' including bottom bales unless stated to the contrary.

At the fall of the hammer the highest bidder will be the successful purchaser and no bidding can be retracted.

Lots entered are for sale, subject to any reserve price by the vendor and will be sold with the option to buy the following lots for the same amount for the same type of bale from the same vendor.

Descriptions of lots provided by the vendor are believed to be correct but the approximate weights or measurements are given as guidance only and prospective purchasers are advised to inspect the lots before the sale day AND soon after the sale and make any queries known the auctioneers.

Payment for all lots is to be on the sale day. Terms of sale are cash or debit card and all fodder must be paid for in full.

Collection of lots from the farms will not be allowed until full payment has been made to the auctioneers.

Vendors must be responsible for checking with the auctioneers when buyers come to collect that payment has been.

Vendors of sold lots will be paid 7 days from the day of the sale.

3. RESERVES

Reserve Prices for any lots must be submitted in writing on this entry form in the space provided. The auctioneers accept no responsibility for selling lots under reserve if no reserve price has been made known to the auctioneers.

4. SUITABILITY

Halls reserve the right to refuse or withdraw any lot from sale at their absolute discretion, without liability.

5. PAYMENT FOR SOLD LOTS

Payment will be made 10 working days from the day of the sale. Our preferred payment method is by bank transfer, please provide your bank details. Please inform us should your bank details change in the future. If no bank details are held, payment will be made via cheque.

6. POCA

Under the Proceeds of Crime Act 2002, we cannot accept single or linked cash payments over 10,000 euros. For any larger payments, please use bank transfer, debit card, or cheque. Where payment is made by cheque, goods may not be removed from the site until receipt of cleared payment. All Halls Livestock and Machinery Auction customers must complete IDV checks before their first purchase. Please provide original copies of the following to be copied and held securely on file:

- One form of photo ID (passport, UK driving licence, etc)
- One document confirming your address (utility bill, bank statement, council tax bill, firearm/shotgun certificate).

Halls reserve the right to carry out online theft and asset verification checks as part of our standard due diligence and customer onboarding procedures. This may include searches via recognised industry databases, including The Equipment Register.

7. DATA PROTECTION

Halls will use the information provided on this form to administer the auction, prepare sale details, contact you, process the sale and comply with legal requirements. This information may be shared with buyers, sellers and others involved in the auction where necessary.
