AUCTIONEERS REMARKS

Halls are favoured with instructions from the Executors of Mr John Bowen deceased to conduct this interesting and complete Farm Dispersal Sale.

This is a very genuine Dispersal Sale of workshop tools, spares and sundries together with farm implements, machinery and vehicles which is only being undertaken due to John's untimely passing in December.

There is a most extensive range of very usable farm implements, machinery, workshop tools, and farming sundries and spares. The sale also includes an unusually large amount of timber (in sawn logs, unsawn logs, and squared logs) and woodworking machines.

The sale is completed by an excellent 2020 JCB 538-60 Agri Super Loadall (6,395hrs) and an immaculate 1994 Ford 8240 4WD Tractor together with 4 x other tractors, diggers & loaders. There is also a 2009 BMW X5 with 63,677 miles on the clock.

There is something for everyone at this sale, so it is not to be missed.

SITUATION AND DIRECTIONS

Lee Hall Farm is situated in the middle of the rural hamlet of Lee Brockhurst, approximately 7 miles north of Shrewsbury Livestock Market/Halls Head Office and approximately 10 miles south of the north Shropshire town of Whitchurch.

From Shrewsbury Livestock Market/Halls Head Office, take the A49 north for approximately 6 ½ miles and turn left signposted Lee Brockhurst. Continue for a short distance and just before Lee Brockhurst the sale field and parking will be found on the left hand side.

From Whitchurch take the A49 south for approx. 10 miles and turn right signposted Lee Brockhurst. Continue for a short distance and just before Lee Brockhurst, the sale field and parking will be found on the left hand side.

All main routes will be signposted on the day of the sale.
