NOTES

BVD eradication in other regions of the British Isles

Many regions of the British Isles have made significant progress in controlling BVD. Scotland, Northern Ireland, and the Republic of Ireland have all implemented eradication programmes.

Northern Ireland

All calves must be tissue tagged within 20 days of birth to identify any remaining PI animals.

From 2025, movement restrictions will be introduced for affected herds which will further limit spread.

Republic of Ireland

Enforced calf testing and herd surveillance screens, with prompt removal of PI animals and movement restrictions have been introduced to prevent spread. This has significantly reduced the number of BVD cases.

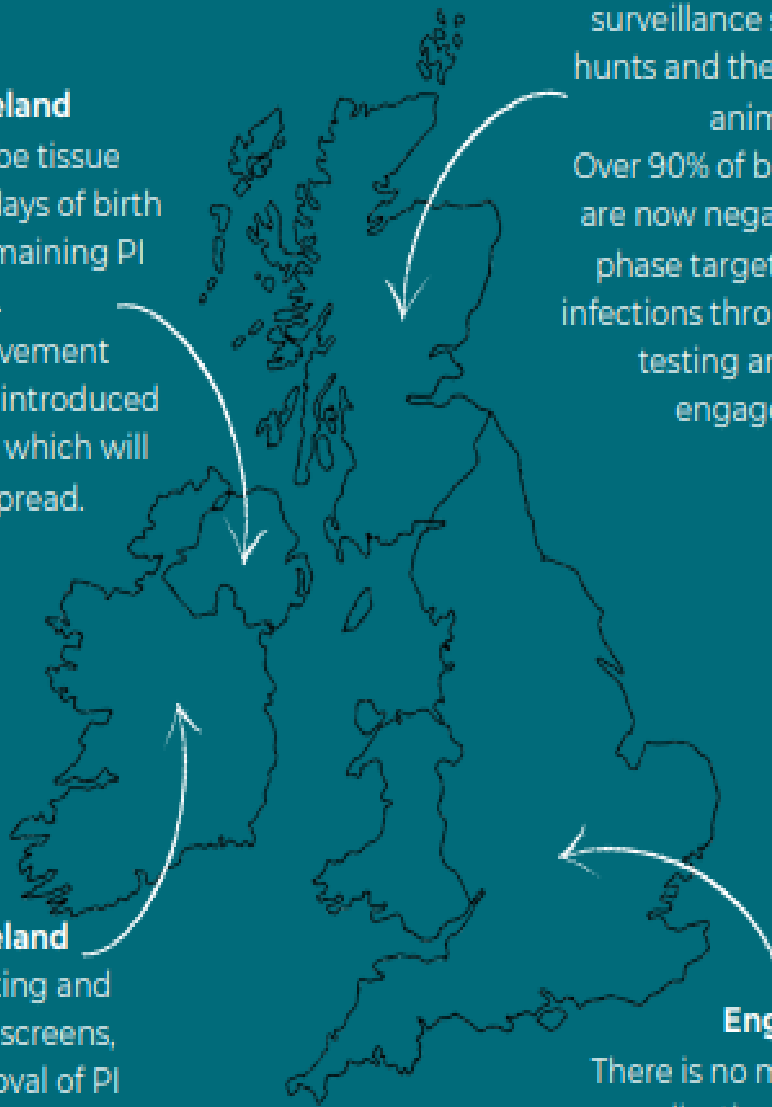
Scotland

Industry-led BVD eradication programme, through surveillance screening, PI hunts and the removal of PI animals.

Over 90% of breeding herds are now negative. The final phase targets remaining infections through continued testing and farmer engagement.

England

There is no mandatory BVD eradication programme. However, the Animal Health and Welfare Pathway will fund work to deal with BVD on farms.



How to become compliant with BVD legislation?

In line with the Bovine Viral Diarrhoea (Wales) order 2024 every farm **must** screen their herd annually for BVD antibodies.

The first annual screen must be carried out by 1 July 2025.

Every farm must screen for BVD - there are no exceptions.

The results of this screen will provide farms with a BVD status and determine if further investigative work is required for legislative compliance.

We anticipate that 80% of herds will screen negative and the only legislative requirement placed on these herds would be to continue to screen annually.

BVD Herd Status:

Every farm will be given a status. The two possible statuses are explained below:

BVD Negative Status

This status is awarded when all five youngstock in each management group tested as part of the annual screen all have a negative antibody result.

Or, when a farm has completed a PI Hunt, all PI animals have been removed, and an application to change the farm status has been submitted.

Next steps:



Maintain Biosecurity.

Continue to screen annually.
